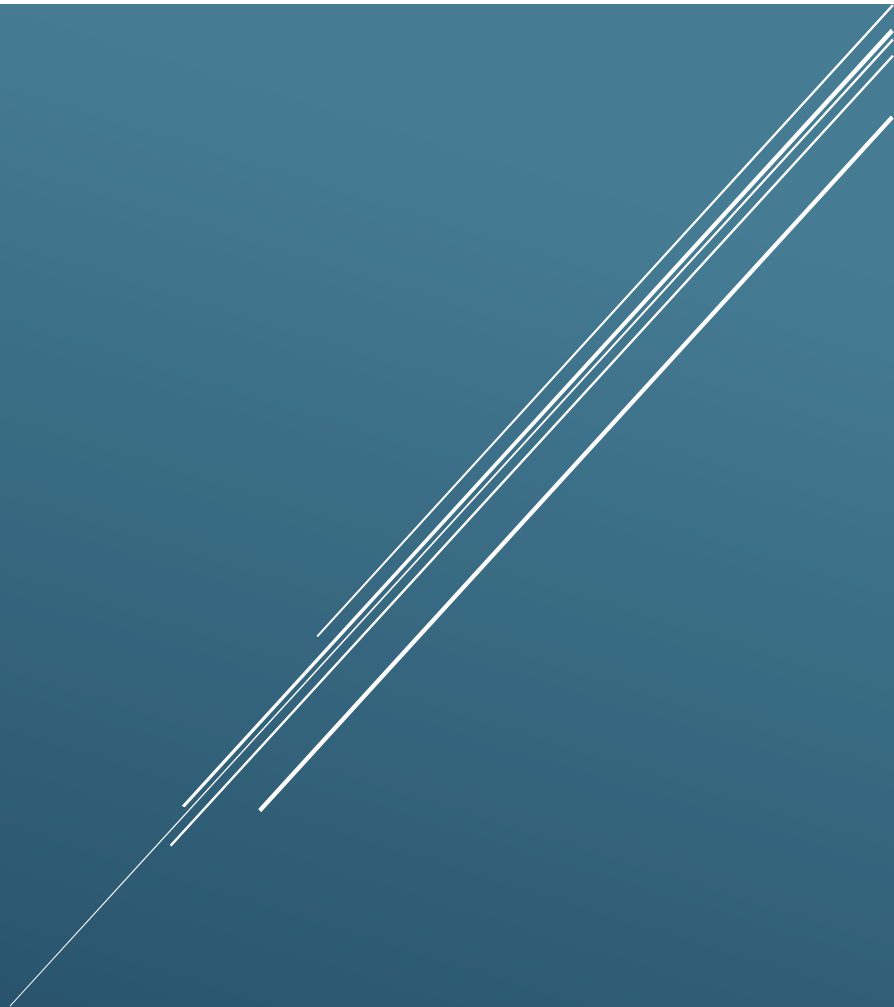




RIDER INFORMATION & RULES

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WAKEBOARD COMPETITION – RIDER INFORMATION & RULES

The goal of this event is to combine sportsmanship, safety, and enjoyment with fair competition for all participants.

By entering the competition, each rider agrees to the following rules.

1. Registration

- All participants must register with the event organization on time.
- Riders must be present at least 30 minutes before the start of their category.
- Wearing an impact vest and/or helmet is mandatory if required by the organizers.
- The organizers reserve the right to combine categories if the number of participants is limited.

2. Safety

- Safety always comes first.
- Follow all instructions given by event staff, officials, and operators at all times.
- Unsportsmanlike or dangerous behavior may result in disqualification.
- The use of alcohol or drugs before or during the competition is prohibited.
- Any equipment issues must be reported immediately to the competition management.

3. Competition Format

- Each rider will receive one or more runs depending on the competition schedule.
- The duration of each run will be determined by the organizers.
- The best run counts towards the final result unless otherwise announced during the riders' meeting.
- The starting order will be announced before the competition begins.

4. Judging

The judges evaluate each run using an “Overall Impression” system.

The following aspects are considered:

- Execution
- Difficulty (Intensity)
- Variety and Creativity (Composition)
- Control and Style
- Use of the Course

The entire run is evaluated, not just individual tricks.

5. Falls & Crashes

- A fall will affect the final score.
- Multiple falls will result in a lower score.
- Riders are encouraged to continue their run after a fall whenever possible.

6. Sportsmanship

Every participant is expected to:

- Show respect towards fellow riders.
- Show respect towards officials and volunteers.
- Keep the competition area clean and tidy.
- Support other participants in a positive sporting atmosphere.

Unsportsmanlike behavior may result in warnings or disqualification.

7. Protests

- Any protest must be submitted to the competition management by the rider, coach, or team captain.
- Protests must be filed within the time limit specified by the organizers.
- The decision of the Head Judge is final.

8. Liability

- Participation is at the rider's own risk.
- The organizers are not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings.
- Riders are responsible for their own equipment.

9. Prize Giving Ceremony

- The prize ceremony will take place according to the competition schedule.
- Prize winners are expected to attend the ceremony.
- Respect for all participants remains a priority.
